

ARKANSAS STATE HORSE SHOW

CAMPERS—TACK TRAILERS—VEHICLES

1. Campers/**horse trailer or living quarter camping**

- **Campers will pay \$35.00 per night per space used**
- All campers will park in areas designated on map with proper number per area
- Campers will plug into red outlets only, these are marked to run campers.
- No campers are allowed to plug into outlets on or in barns or buildings
- All campers must use the following type of cords only, if cord does not meet these specs or is not in good shape do not bring it
- You can not run a cord from red outlet (supply) then add 5 more cords to the end. There is not enough power to do that
- All of the above items will be monitored by ALSA security staff. Anyone caught not following the rules will be asked to unplug and not use the facilities

2. TACK TRAILERS

- Tack trailers will be allowed to plug into blue outlets on outside of barns only
- These trailers must be designated on the map for this usage only
- The trailers must also use same type of cords set aside as stated above in camper section

3. VEHICLES

- All vehicles must not be parked in the roadways or fire lanes at anytime
- Any vehicle having to be towed may be picked up at the compound in front of the Hall of Industry for a fee.
- No four-wheeler, mopeds, will be allowed on the fairgrounds for contestants or family. (exception: handicap scooters/golf carts will be allowed)
- **only people on the approved list will be allowed to have Golf carts on the grounds. Proper paper work must accompany. Drivers of the golf cart MUST be 18 years old or older.**

4. MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

- All purpose outlets inside barns are for use in building only
- All power outlets on outside of building (red or blue) are for camper or tack trailer use only
- Remember one power outlet will only run so many items at once, so be more careful of what you try to run off a single (110) outlet
